

We were happy to help support the Musicians' Club of Pomona Valley.










CELEBRATING

Rev Dr. Les Bishop was there also, as Pastor Narcissis was sick and unable to attend. It was held on February 8, 2025 at the First Presbyterian Church of Santa Ana where Nelson served as an interim pastor. As we listened to different people speak about Nelson, it was quite evident that he truly was a servant for God and certainly had his same sense of humor. His missionary work for the Lord was far reaching not only in the U.S. but internationally as well. He served as pastor for Westminster, a Chaplain at the Downey hospital for almost 10 years, and returned to the pulpit in 2022. Linda Grande (his wife of nine years who was also secretary of our church) was so pleased to see us from Westminster.


