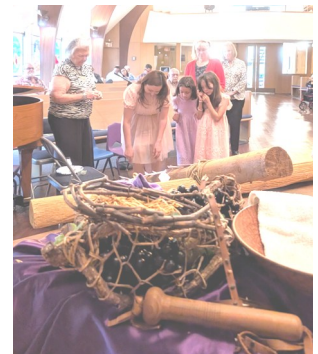




# Sacred Walk to the Cross

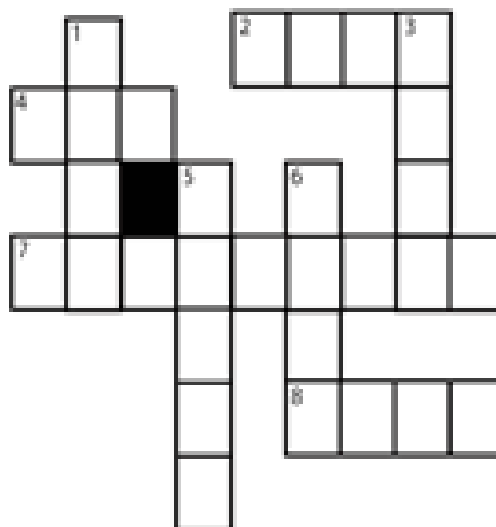
